MEDIUM CONDITIONS

If outside, do not apply if rain is forecast, in strong midday sun or on very humid days.

MEDIUM PREPARATION

NON-PAINTED OR NEW SURFACES

- \cdot Surfaces should be dry and free of grease, dust and rust, etc.
- The use of blasting to Sa 2 ½ is advisable for preparing the surface. If the requirements are not stringent, manual or mechanical preparations to St 3 may be applied, provided that this is done in inside areas without risk of condensation. Apply one or two coats of TKROM MATTE QUICK DRY PRIMER.

ALREADY PAINTED SURFACES

· Use mechanical equipment, scrapers or wire brushes to remove rusted areas and poorly bonded paint. Clean away dust, grease and dirt. Check adhesion to the previous layer and, if insufficient, proceed as described for new surfaces.

PRODUCT PREPARATION	· Stir until the mixture is properly homogenised.	
	· Stir again at regular intervals.	
	· Adjust viscosity.	
	 Evaporation will take place during prolonged application, so the viscosity will have to be adjusted. 	
	 If the thinning agent is very strong, the proportion may have to be reduced. 	
APPLICATION	· It can be applied with a roller or a spray gun.	
	 It can be applied with a short hair roller to obtain the proper thickness with two perpendicular layers and dilution at 10%. 	
	 For spray gun application, use a pressure of 3-5 bar and 1.5 to 2 mm nozzles, diluted to 10%-15% and apply two layers crossing each other. 	
	 When using airless paint spraying equipment, the output pressure should be 150 bar, using 0.3-0.4 mm nozzles, with dilution at 5%- 10% and an application angle of 75°-80°. Apply two layers crossing each other. 	
	 The second coat of the product should always be applied perpendicular to the first coat to obtain ideal opacity. 	
TOOL CLEANING	• All tools that are used must be cleaned immediately after use with any of the recommended thinners, or with TKROM 302 UNIVERSAL THINNER (TDS-6961).	

WAIT TIMES

Drying at 20°C and 65% relative humidity: The product is touch dry in 10-15 minutes. Tack free after 20-25 minutes. Below can be found a short guide to painting over, depending on the recommended product. These times are for perfect atmospheric conditions. Therefore, if possible it is advisable to paint over after 24 hours.

The product may be painted over with any type of paint, synthetic enamel,

Chlorinated rubber, polyurethane, etc. However, the amount of time before the primer can be

painted over will vary depending on the paint that will be applied. Paints containing very vigorous thinners will require longer primer drying times. The suitability of the system to be applied must first be verified. Never use universal solvents on top coats; use specific solvents in each case.

Synthetic enamels: 12 hours, diluted with TKROM 345 synthetic thinner TDS-6914.

Epoxy: A minimum of 24 hours, diluted with our TKROM 370 epoxy thinner TDS-6919.

Polyurethane: A minimum of 24 hours, diluted with our TKROM 310 Polyurethane Thinner TDS-6903.

Quick drying: 6-8 hours, diluted with our TKROM 345 synthetic thinner TDS-6914.

Chloro Rubber: 6-8 hours, diluted with our TKROM 350 Chlorinated Rubber Thinner TDS-6934.
